Application deadline Friday, March 19, 2021

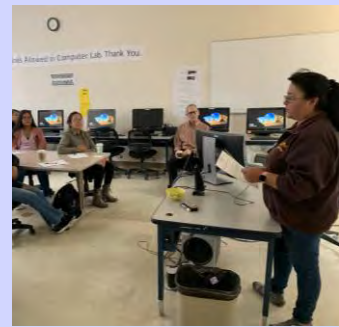
A **10-week online program** designed to prepare Native American undergraduate college students for careers in public health and health research.

The program has three stages:

- Stage 1** Intensive 3-week online training in Public Health Research Methods
- Stage 2** Six-week mentored online internship
- Stage 3** One week online data analysis workshop and presentation

While participating in SREP, students receive the following:

- ❖ \$3,920 stipend (distributed in installments)
- ❖ 7 transferrable college credits hours in Public Health (PUH 290/297 or PUH 490/497)
- ❖ Tuition, books and materials for the Public Health courses required for SREP
